Use this do-it-yourself Kitchen Scale for measuring precise portions of venison and other meat. Great after the hunt so you can really brag about how big your buck was!

Whether you're measuring tubs full of venison from your recent hunt or prepping hamburger patties for the grill, our Guide Gear® Food Scale is up to the task. The large, easy-to-read dial measures from 0 to 44 lbs. with incredible accuracy, and the inner dial ranges from 0 to 20 kilograms. And since it doesn't require electricity or batteries, you can get to work right out of the box!

- Use the right scale for the job. DO NOT attempt to force small equipment to do the work of larger industrial equipment. There are certain applications for which this scale was designed. This scale will be safer and do a better job at the capacity for which it was intended. DO NOT use this scale for a purpose for which it was not intended.
- Industrial or commercial applications must follow OSHA requirements.
- Check for damaged parts before each use. Carefully check that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Never operate the product with a damaged part.
- Store the product when it is not in use. Inspect the scale for good working condition prior to storage and before re-use.

Operating Instructions

- 1. Set the platform on a level surface. Using bolts, attach the cross bracket to the platform and the tray to the bracket.
- 2. Adjust the zero value by winding the adjustable nut until the dial points to zero; then check by slightly pressing the tray down and releasing it.
- 3. Load the scale slowly, avoiding sudden or heavy impacts to the spring.
- 4. Look at the dial vertically when weighing.
- 5. The weight of the item being weighed should exceed the weighing increment (the weighing increment is five times the scale code. Avoid going beyond the capacity of the scale, as this could damage interior parts and/or cause malfunction.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Use a soft cloth and mild cleanser to clear the platform.
- Do NOT use gas, lacquer thinner or other strong chemicals.
- Do not drop or impact the scale.
- Do not remove or tamper with inner parts of the scale.
- Do not allow acid, alkali or water to infiltrate the scale.
