Join one leg with the shelf, as shown. Repeat to join the three other legs. Apply glue inside this holes before each insertion.



Lay the top flat on the ground and insert the legs, as shown. Apply glue inside the holes before each insertion.



Set the table on its legs to stabilize it. Make sure the top is level. If not, make adjustments at the joints by varying the depth of insertion on the parts. Finally nail the joints to strengthen them as illustrated.







Make sure that the wood grain is the same for the shelf and the top of the side table.



Nail joints at a perpendicular angle only.
