- ALWAYS make sure the cot is completely dry before storing in the carry bag.

## Assembly Instructions

1. Remove the cot and end bar supports from the carry bag.
2. Set aside both end bar supports.
3. Fold out the legs and let the cot stand on the ground. Be cautious when unfolding the legs to avoid pinching fingers and hands.
4. Slide the shorter end bar through the fabric pocket on one end of the cot, making sure the notches on the end bar are positioned as shown in Figure 3. The notch will fit over the button on the cot when positioned correctly. Push down the lock into place.
5. After securing the shorter bar, repeat Step 4 with the remaining end bar on the opposite end of the cot. It may be necessary to stretch the fabric to get the longer end bar into position. (See EZ-Set Mechanism Box)
6. Secure the rod latches as shown in Figure 4 for each corner.

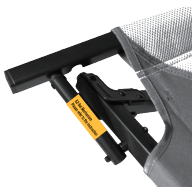

### EZ-Set Mechanism



Insert mini-diameter tube into the hole and swivel it as the rotation arrow shows. Make sure the square tube press down exactly into the notch until it's locked.



This "EZ-Set Mechanism" makes assembling this cot easier than many traditional cots. This function based on other three corners are fixed.
